Re: Defibrillator Security

We write to ask for retrospective permission to install CCTV at the EBFC pavilion. We assumed that verbal permission was sufficient as the cameras are not directed into a public area.

On advice from The British Heart Foundation the football club purchased an unlocked cabinet in which to house the defibrillator. A lot of defibrillators are kept in locked cabinets, however, as time is a major factor in these sorts of emergencies, we wanted anyone who needs it to have instant access, without wasting valuable life saving time having to phone for a code to unlock a locked cabinet.

Because the unit is in a slightly remote area, the supplier Wel Medical Ltd., recommended that we install CCTV to protect it and deter vandalism.

The CCTV is directed only towards the defibrillator unit and recordings will be deleted every two weeks without being viewed. The images will only be used if a crime is committed. The recording system is kept in a locked cupboard and Mr Richard Pearce, Treasurer, is the only member with access and will be responsible for this.

Should the defibrillator be stolen or vandalised it may have fatal consequences for some misfortunate person. It goes without saying that this equipment doesn't come cheap and more importantly it is a valuable asset which we would like to remain accessible to the public. The installation of CCTV is purely to deter vandalism and safe guard it. We have complied with The Surveillance Camera Code of Practice.

Therefore, we hope the Parish Council will allow this important equipment, available to everyone, to be protected by the installation of CCTV.
