

Clerks Notes for April 2023

The Clerk has submitted a request for two salt/grit bins to come from County Councillor Christine Channon's Locality Budget. – with her agreement. The likely cost is £273 x 2 = 546. The PC to provide the salt – cost estimated at £136.00

Fords will replace the exterior lights of the Public Toilets, but not until May and have been asked to site the sensors to provide sufficient light for both entrances.

Mike Tucker, the Principal Transport Officer at County Hall, has responded to our query about bus changes and delays. Stagecoach is a private company on a limited budget, so there is very little likelihood that they will place notices to better inform the public about bus route changes. They are relying on the increase in digital use in the future.

Bagwells replaced the Carpark lights and adjusted the sensors to come as soon as the light levels drop.

There were minor issues with water overflowing in the public toilets. This has been resolved. Fords did not complete the work on fitting a new cistern & need to replace a "new" faulty switch. They have apologised and will complete the work soon.

The Clerk and Chair are still awaiting the much-delayed signing of an easement so that Rohallion may be connected to the mains. The Clerk has been in touch with the solicitors and with Mr. Hassell, the owner, but the matter has not yet been signed off.
