SPEED WATCH

There are weekly sessions, providing the people are free to attend and are now back to 2 sites again (one was lost early last year due to circumstances) so now both ends will be covered again and should help slow people down.

On average there are between 8 & 14 speeding offences each time and there have been a few who have been caught a few times.

It is too early to ascertain how effective the new speed indicators have been in slowing traffic.

FLOOD SUPPORT

DEFIBRILLATOR

The defibrillator in Yettington has no permanent lighting. The only lighting is activated by a motion sensor inside the cabinet. An always battery powered light could be installed inside cabinet but it is unknown how long it will stay illuminated. The batteries in the existing motion sensor light have been changed.
