## Parish Paths Partnership report for October 2022

I attended a P3 workshop for East and Mid Devon coordinators. The presentations included: 1) Public Rights-of-Way Definitive Mapping, which is ongoing in our parish, so nothing new there; 2) PRoW improvement planning - carried out on a regular basis at the behest of central Government, but little about execution or financing of these aspirations; and 3) Devon CC PRoW group staff changes, budget (no cuts as yet), and examples of completed parish path projects.

LORP work on the footpath between Frogmore Road and the River Otter (EB1/Otterton 1a) is finished and the path diversion removed. There are warning signs on the lowered section of the bank about possible flooding at spring tides. This is predicted to be for brief periods and no more than twenty times a year. The danger from less common river flooding is also noted.
