Report from Councillor Kevin Quant – September 2021

1. Yettington Speedwatch:

The last four sessions conducted on various days and times has seen the number of offending vehicles drop by nearly 50%.

In total 13 sessions have taken place, with 113 vehicles exceeding 35mph, 64 letters have been sent out by D&C.

2. Phone Box:

Canvassing of Yettington residents in respect to a defibrillator located in the phone box has seen a positive response. One of the residents is a practising GP who strongly advocates the importance of defibs.

3. Funding of bench for Councillor Barnard:

The original bench sourced from B&Q is no longer available, have found another similar bench from another supplier. £150.

Sue, wife of Peter has sourced a tradesman to install the bench using appropriate materials to make the bench permanent and safe. If all happy, I would like to go ahead and order the item ?

4. Finger Road sign:

The application for funding of materials has been sent via the Highway Maintenance Community Enhancement Fund.
