### Concern over car parking space when the Sir Walter Raleigh gets busy

The SWR Management Committee are aware of the issue and will issue a policy. Notices will be displayed in the pub to encourage people to walk, park further away or share lifts where possible. Lifts to and from the pub may also be made available. See also this idea suggested by a member of the Management Committee : "It occurs to me that there may be some 10 possible parking spaces on the Yettington Road close up to the All Saints wall where the road widens. It may be helpful to designate/mark the road discretely as parking formally before it becomes a problem. This area gets used Sunday mornings for church parking and for weddings/funerals. Otherwise it is freely available roadside parking I think. Perhaps that can be confirmed by the East Budleigh Parish Council. Perhaps signage can encourage people to walk through the churchyard to the pub/village and avoid the bend in the road.
