

Report on Village Hall from Cllr. Louis Allan

The Village Hall Trustees held a further 'open afternoon' on Monday 13 November to once more invite comments and suggestions from villagers regarding the plans for a refurbished village hall. The inputs from this session and the earlier one held in October will be collated and discussed and refined at their next meeting in December.

One feature of the present proposals is the provision of an externally accessible 'all-comers' toilet with no steps and a wide doorway. It is for consideration whether the scope of this facility might be extended, such that the expensive, PC maintained toilets in the village carpark might be repurposed and perhaps generate some income.

In the meantime, an energy efficiency survey of the village hall and shop has been carried out by 'Utility Aid' - the results are awaited.
