TELEPHONE BOX SUGGESTIONS



1. VILLAGE MUSEUM/INFORMATION

The kiosk could house a village museum, displaying the history of the village and a guide to local sites of interest.

Information on local walks, and the Village Nature Trail could also be provided.

We could investigate improving the wifi signal and potential QR codes for people to download leaflets to their smart phones.

Volunteers would be responsible for cleaning and maintenance.

2. SEED EXCHANGE

A proposal from East Budleigh in Bloom, inspired by Gardeners World. The idea is to put up shelving on one inside wall for boxes labelled with different types of seeds. For example Flowers A-F, Flowers G-L, Vegetables M-R, Vegetables S-Z. Herbs etc.

People could also donate seeds in labelled bags, it could include a note book for requests and ideas and a notice board for inspirations. There could also be a collection of free gardening magazines and information.

This would be maintained by East Budleigh in Bloom.





3. BOOK/DVD EXCHANGE

This could be run as an addition or alternative to the current book exchange in the VIP, which currently has a turnover of around 30 books per week..

Shelving at the back of the kiosk would provide ample room for a larger selection of books with the addition of a DVD exchange.

This may be a more visible place to display the books, and could incorporate elements of the other two suggestions.
